



Class 1 - Quilting 101

Introduction

Have you always wished you could make a quilt of your own, but didn't know where to start? This class is for you! We will start slow - review the tools of the trade - all the basic need-to-know information to make you a quilter. But beware! Once you start - you won't be able to stop!

Fabrics/Materials Needed

We will start with the classic log cabin block and make two placemats. You will need:

(3) - (4) fat quarters of dark fabrics (any color of your choice)

(3) - (4) fat quarters of light fabrics (any color of your choice)

A small piece of contrasting fabric (traditionally red or yellow) for the center square of the blocks

Make sure that your fabrics (lights and darks) have contrast! If you aren't sure what to get, we can spend a little time at the beginning of class finding the appropriate fabrics.

Supplies

Basic Quilting Supplies:

- Rotary Cutter, mat & rulers
- Pins
- marking pens or chalk pencils
- Sewing machine, thread, bobbins
- Scissors
